Day 01 – Arrival in Sri Lanka & Colombo



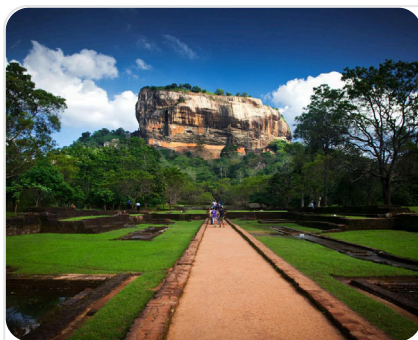
Welcome to Sri Lanka!

Day 02 – Colombo to Sigiriya



After breakfast, depart for the Cultural Triangle and journey towards Sigiriya.

In the afternoon, climb the legendary Sigiriya Rock Fortress, a UNESCO World Heritage Site often referred to as the "Eighth Wonder of the World."

Explore the magnificent water gardens, ancient frescoes, Mirror Wall, Lion's Paw, and the summit, which offers spectacular panoramic views across the surrounding countryside.

Please note that the entrance fee to Sigiriya Rock Fortress is not included and can be paid directly by you.

Day 03 – Polonnaruwa Ancient Kingdom & Minneriya Safari



After breakfast, visit the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Polonnaruwa Ancient City, the medieval capital of Sri Lanka.

Explore magnificent royal palaces, sacred temples, monasteries, and the famous Gal Vihara rock-cut Buddha statues.

Please note that the entrance fee to Polonnaruwa Ancient City is not included and can be paid directly by you.

Later in the afternoon, enjoy an exciting safari at Minneriya National Park, Eco Park, or Kaudulla National Park depending on seasonal wildlife movements.

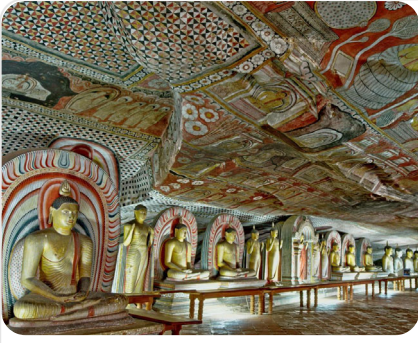
Look out for elephants, deer, crocodiles, monkeys, and numerous bird species in their natural habitat.

Please note that the National Park entrance fee and safari jeep charges are not included and can be paid directly by you.

Day 04 – Dambulla Cave Temple & Kandy



After breakfast, visit the impressive Dambulla Cave Temple, Sri Lanka's largest and best-preserved cave temple complex.

The temple houses hundreds of Buddha statues and stunning murals dating back over 2,000 years.

Please note that the entrance fee to Dambulla Cave Temple is not included and can be paid directly by you.

Continue to Kandy, Sri Lanka's last royal capital.

Visit the sacred Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic, one of Buddhism's most important pilgrimage sites.

Please note that the entrance fee to the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic is not included and can be paid directly by you.

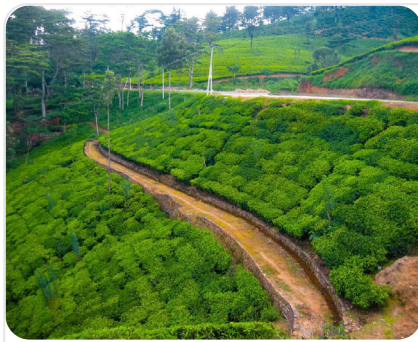
In the evening, witness a traditional Kandyan Cultural Show featuring drumming, dancing, and fire performances.

Please note that the cultural show entrance fee is not included and can be paid directly by you.

Day 05 – Peradeniya Botanical Gardens, Tea Plantation & Nuwara Eliya



After breakfast, visit the beautiful Royal Botanical Gardens, home to one of Asia's finest collections of tropical plants, orchids, palms, and giant trees.

Please note that the entrance fee to the Royal Botanical Gardens is not included and can be paid directly by you.

Continue through the heart of Sri Lanka's tea-growing region and visit a tea plantation and factory to discover how world-famous Ceylon Tea is produced.

Arrive in Nuwara Eliya, affectionately known as "Little England."

Enjoy a city tour featuring Gregory Lake, the colonial post office, historic buildings, and beautifully maintained gardens.

Day 06 – Scenic Train Journey to Ella & Transfer to Yala



After breakfast, proceed to Ambewela Railway Station to board the scenic train to Ella.

Widely regarded as one of the most beautiful train journeys in the world, this unforgettable ride travels through Sri Lanka's breathtaking hill country. Admire rolling tea plantations, mist-covered mountains, waterfalls, tunnels, and picturesque villages along the route.

Upon arrival, visit the famous Nine Arch Bridge, one of Sri Lanka's most photographed landmarks.

Continue towards Yala, stopping at the beautiful Ravana Falls along the way.

Day 07 – Yala Safari, Galle Fort & Bentota

After this unforgettable wildlife adventure, continue your journey to **Galle** for an engaging city tour.

Discover the historic **Galle Fort**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, stroll through its charming cobbled streets, and admire its unique blend of colonial heritage and coastal beauty.

Conclude your tour in **Bentota**, where you may extend your stay and relax on Sri Lanka's golden beaches.
